

Bible Study "The Book of Mysteries" Lesson 9 (110-139)

Day 110 The two Three Thousands. This is a really good one and I will expand on this at Pentecost Sunday. The Law can tell us the will of God, but only the Spirit can give us the power to live it. Write down your thoughts and inspirations from this lesson.

** Day 112 The Mystery of the Cherubim This is another Good Friday lesson. Most of us know the story of the Curtain the "parochet" that separated the Holy of Holies in the temple and in the tabernacle. It was torn in two when Christ died, but did you know WHAT was on the curtain? Cherubim. It was the Cherubim with flaming swords that separated Man from the garden of Eden and now they separated man from the Holy of Holies. The tearing now removed the barrier of the Cherubim.

Day 114 The fourth Creature. This is an amazing revelation and I would love to talk for hours on what I have researched and studied and compiled for years. The main take away is that the first three creatures are natural and the fourth is not. It is machine. It is unnatural. It goes against the natural. Unfortunately, there is too much here to write in note form. Jesus said those who have eyes let them see and those who have ears let them hear.

Day 115 The Scroll of Days Did you ever think about a scroll, how it works? You can only see what's inside the scroll..... as it unrolls. Unlike a book you cannot skip around, or read the ending you HAVE to read what is in front of you at the time. So with your life, you can never be shown all that lies ahead of you. You wouldn't understand it. Just like learning the answer to the big mystery at the end of the book. If you didn't read the book you might not understand the ending. God's plan for your life are already written and finished. Everything in the scroll is connected and so it is with our lives. Since you can only see the part of the scroll that is in front of you so too live in the present.

Day 118 The Cosmic Bridal Chamber You can add this one to the Bride/ Groom list. The main theme is when the Bride is preparing for her wedding day she is NO longer focusing on her former home but focusing on her NEW home with her groom. If you belong to God, you're His bride. The world is your tent, your present home. This is the place you are leaving, our focus should be on our eternal home.

**Day 120 The Mystery of the Semikhah (Good Friday) This is the lesson that talks about the priest offering the sacrifice had to make contact by touching the sacrifice on the head. Since Messiah is the sacrifice, during the "trial" Passover night the priests repeatedly struck him with their hands. For the Semikhah to be accomplished, they had to touch the head of the sacrifice with their hands. Each and every detail no matter how small was NOT unnoticed and orchestrated by God to accomplish the bigger picture.

Day 123 The Mystery of Spring The Hebrew year has two cycles Spring and Autumn with Holy days attached to each. The Spring is end of winter, new life, the Passover, the lamb, the sacrifice, first fruits, new beginnings, new birth, new harvests, the resurrection. The spring cycle holds the mystery of Messiah's first coming. When you receive Messiah, it is then that the spring cycle begins. He makes everything new. This is exciting news for all that are born again! Something that we should share.

**Day 124 The seventh day God created everything in 6 days and calls the 7th day the Sabbath or day of rest. Man was created on the sixth day. Jesus died for man's sins on the 6th day. Where was Jesus on the 7th day? In the tomb and what was he doing? Resting..... in the tomb. Jesus finished his labor so that the Sabbath could come, the sign that His work was done. What are your thoughts on this lesson?

Day 125 The Temple Lambs (Christmas) Sheep were not allowed by Jerusalem, yet, to have sacrificial lambs there had to be lambs close by. An exception was made, the flocks or lambs that were specifically appointed and destined for the Temple sacrifices in the Holy City were allowed in the town of Bethlehem. That's why Messiah was born in Bethlehem! The Lamb of God was born in the place where the sacrificial lambs were born. That's why the first ones to see the Messiah were the shepherds that witnessed the birth of all of the sacrificial lambs. How COOL IS THAT!

Day 128 Dunamehee: The Power of I Can Messiah gave His disciples and all who would come after them, the Great Commission of proclaiming the message of salvation. Dunamahee means to be able, to make possible. What power is given to you in the spirit? Power given by the Holy Spirit to do that which you could never had done before. So if you live by the Spirit, you will have the power to make possible that which was not possible. It also means I Can, The power of the Spirit *is the power of I Can*. You have been given the power to do all things, anything whatever you need to do to fulfill the will and calling of God. The gifts of the Spirit. Spend some time pondering this lesson. Go to 1 Corinthians 12. Read, study and ponder this chapter. What is God or the Spirit telling or showing you right now? If you do not hear anything give it more time by continuing to ponder this lesson.

Day 131 The Unscriptures Have you ever thought about the two parts to a paper that you write on? One the part that you have written, but what is the second? Have you ever heard the term read between the lines? What does that mean? The paper itself is the second part. Looking at the scriptures in the Bible the black is the Word of God it is holy. However, the white is also holy Without it you wouldn't see the black of the ink. Without the white you would not "see" the Word of God! The white is the sacred unscripture of God. Your life is the white upon which the black Word of God is written. Ponder this concept how does it make you feel? Did it change your perspective?

Day 134 The skeleton Prophecy No this is NOT the zombie apocalypse, but one might read it that way at face value. What was Ezekiel prophesying? The return of Israel. The return of a mighty nation where

once it had been dried up. But now the impossible has been made possible when Israel became a nation in 1947. Over 2000 years later the prophesy came true!

Day 135 The Preemptor This is quite the visual lesson, especially if you do not like snakes. But an egg swallowing serpent, makes a big visual as to what Satan tried to do to swallow up the egg or seed of Messiah. He tried to wipe out man not once, but twice (Adam and Noah) then he tried to have Moses wiped out as a baby, then by King Herod decree to kill Messiah, the temptations and challenge to kill Jesus in the wilderness. And then again in the end with Judas, and Christ's death on the cross. He attacks the purposes of God not only after they begin, but before they begin. So when you're in the will of God and all hell comes against you, don't be discouraged. Be encouraged! The enemy is doing everything he can to keep God's purpose from being accomplished.

** Day 137 Shalom Aleichem On Easter when Jesus first greets his disciples he says "Peace be to you" he said it twice in the same encounter and it is the ONLY time record of Messiah saying those words. Peace only comes after the atonement is made, so it was only AFTER Messiah died on the cross and rose that peace could be given. But Jesus didn't say Peace instead he said Shalom. While Shalom means peace, it also means a lot more, safety, rest, prosperity, wholeness, welfare, completion, fullness, soundness and even well-being. All that in one blessing. And all of that because and in His Sacrifice His shalom.

Day 138 The Leper King Good Friday The Tractate Sanhedrin described Messiah as a Leper, the one afflicted for our transgressions as prophesied by Isaiah. He was bruised for our inequities, the punishment that brought us peace fell upon Him. By His stripes, we are healed, .. the Lord laid upon Him the iniquity of us all. He was oppressed and He was afflicted, yet He did not open His mouth; He is brought as a lamb to the slaughter... He was cut off from the land of the living; for the transgressions of My people to whom the stroke was due. **By condemning Him to death on the charge of NOT being the Messiah, they caused HIM to be despised and rejected, wounded, afflicted, bruised, punished and killed. To become the very One they described as their Messiah. The Sanhedrin's Leper King is Messiah.

Day 139 The Apokalupsis Did you know that the root word for apocalypse means to remove a veil or covering. What do you do at a wedding? You remove the brides veil. At the end of Revelation, the end of days you find what? A Bride and a Bridegroom a wedding. When the bride and groom after a long separation finally come face to face. The bride lifts her veil and there is no more separation! This lesson gives a whole new outlook on the "scary apocalypse" that we have conjured up in our minds. Instead of doom and gloom and darkness it is a time of uniting, celebrating, becoming one. It is anticipation but an excited anticipation for the arrival of the Groom and we will see him face to face unveiled!
